# **How Should I Practice?**

**Be Consistent**: Practicing a small amount on a regular basis is better than a large amount once a week. Document your practice: aka "Practice Record" – Due on Fridays **Set a Goal and Make a Plan**: Determine what you need to practice and how you are going to accomplish your goal **Be Prepared**: Have everything you need: Quiet Space, Music, Pencil, Reeds, Oils, Instrument, etc.

**Use Technology:** Metronome, Tuner, Video Record Yourself **Good Technique**: back straight, feet flat on the floor – imagine Mrs. Barclift is sitting beside you. What would she say?

# Why Music Education?

**Music is Science**: It is exact and specific. Printed music is a chart which indicates intensity, volume, melody, and harmony all at once and with an exact control of time.

**Music is Math**: It is rhythmically based on the subdivision of time into fractions which is done instantaneously, not on paper.

**Music is Foreign Language**: Terms are Italian, German, or French and the notations are certainly not English. Music is a complete and universal language.

**Music is History**: Music usually reflects the environment and times of its creation, often the national or ethnic mood. Civilizations are defined by their art.

**Music is PE**: It requires coordination of fingers, hands, arms, lip, cheek and other facial muscles, in addition to control of the diaphragm, back, stomach, and chest muscles. These all respond instantly to the sound the ear hears and the mind interprets.

**Above all, Music is** *ART*: Art encompasses the one thing everything above doesn't have – *EMOTION*.

# The Big Picture

#### Welcome!

Welcome to the Broad Creek Middle School Band. This document is intended to serve as a reference for you throughout the school year. Parental support is critical to the individual growth of child. Being a part of the band instantly creates a team of members with a unified goal. I'm so excited that you have decided to be involved with music this school year!

#### **Instruments/Music**

Students are learning a skill in band. The process of reading music takes place through the development of their collective and individual progress. There are a variety of instruments used in "Concert Band". In general, here are the instrument "families" in the band:

- Woodwinds: Flute, Oboe, Bassoon, Clarinet, Saxophone
- Brass: Trumpet, French Horn, Trombone, Euphonium, Tuba

• Percussion: Snare & Mallets (plus school provided equipment) Students are required to come to class daily with their required instruments and music. Inability to participate hinders the "team".

<u>Performance Attendance</u> –Concerts are a fun time to show off the great music taking place at school. (an easy 100)
